Please see below for important information about CARES Act Grants.

CARES Act Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) Grant

Ursuline College has received federal funding from the Cares Act, which helps students who incurred expenses due to the move to on-line learning because of the pandemic.

You may be eligible for HEERF Grants if you meet the following criteria:

- You were enrolled in Spring Semester classes as of March 13th
- You are a *degree-seeking* student at Ursuline College
- You are a **US Citizen or resident alien**
- You were **not enrolled exclusively in online classes** before 3-26-2020
- Have a 2019-20 or 2020-21 FAFSA on file at the college at the time the HEERF Grant application is reviewed. Visit <u>studentaid.gov</u> to complete the FAFSA if you have not already done so.

Students can request funds for possible expenses in these categories:

- Technology
- Course Materials
- Housing
- Food
- Healthcare out-of-pocket expenses
- Childcare
- Travel
- Other Expenses

Remember that grants are for student expenses incurred directly as a result of the disruption of campus operations due to the pandemic. Requests should be for necessary and reasonable costs related to COVID-19.

Grant requests will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Please be aware that funding is limited, therefore maximum grant amounts will depend on need and the number of applications received. Decisions on grants are final. Students may complete only one application. Verification of expenses submitted for a grant may be requested.
